### Leaves

Rhododendrons have large leathery leaves.



### Truss

A terminal cluster of flowers or fruit arising from one stalk.



### Flower

Rhododendrons flowers are tubular-, funnel-, or bell-shaped.



### Trunk

With textured bark and twisting forms, Rhododendron trunks make a great place to play.



### Stamen

The pollen-producing reproductive organ of a flower. Rhodies have 10 or more stamens.



### Water

Rhododendrons plants need about an inch of water each week, whether by rain or by the watering can!



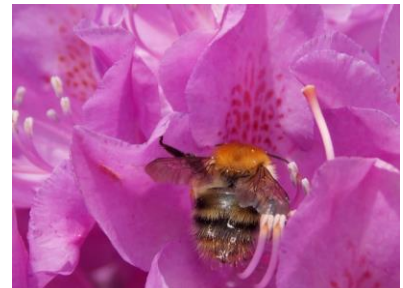
### Dappled

Areas where there is a mixture of sun and shade, generally caused by a tree.



### Bud

A small lateral or terminal protuberance on the stem of a plant that may develop into a flower, leaf, or shoot.



### Pollinator

An agent (such as an insect) that pollinates flowers.
