



Hidden Hollow at Home

Tissue Paper RHODODENDRON



Materials

- Scissors
- 1 pipe cleaner
- Three sheets of tissue paper

Preparation

1. Stack three sheets of tissue paper. If you are feeling adventurous mix and match colors for a layered look.
2. Fold the stack of paper back and forth in an accordion fold (like a fan).
3. Cut the edges to make them round like the petals of a Rhododendron.
4. Use a pipe cleaner to wrap around the center, creating a stem. Secure it by wrapping the pipe cleaner around the tissue paper bundle a few times.
5. Gently separate the layers and fluff the layers to make your Rhodie bloom!

Enhancements

- For extra credit, try adding leaves made of construction paper!
- Use a marker to add dimension to your flower. Many Rhododendrons have speckled pigmentation within the flower.
