


1899 WintonAlexander Winton was a Cleveland bicycle maker who became a great pioneer auto builder. His first cars were built in 1898. This Winton one-cylinder family carriage originally sold for \$1,500.







Ransome E. Olds wanted the car that bore his name to be small and inexpensive, but he couldn't get his partner to agree. Mr. Olds left the Oldsmobile Company and started a new firm. His first car, in 1904, had an 8-horsepower engine and sold for \$650. A later model, pictured here, had a 20-horsepower engine and sold for \$1,050. HERITAGE
