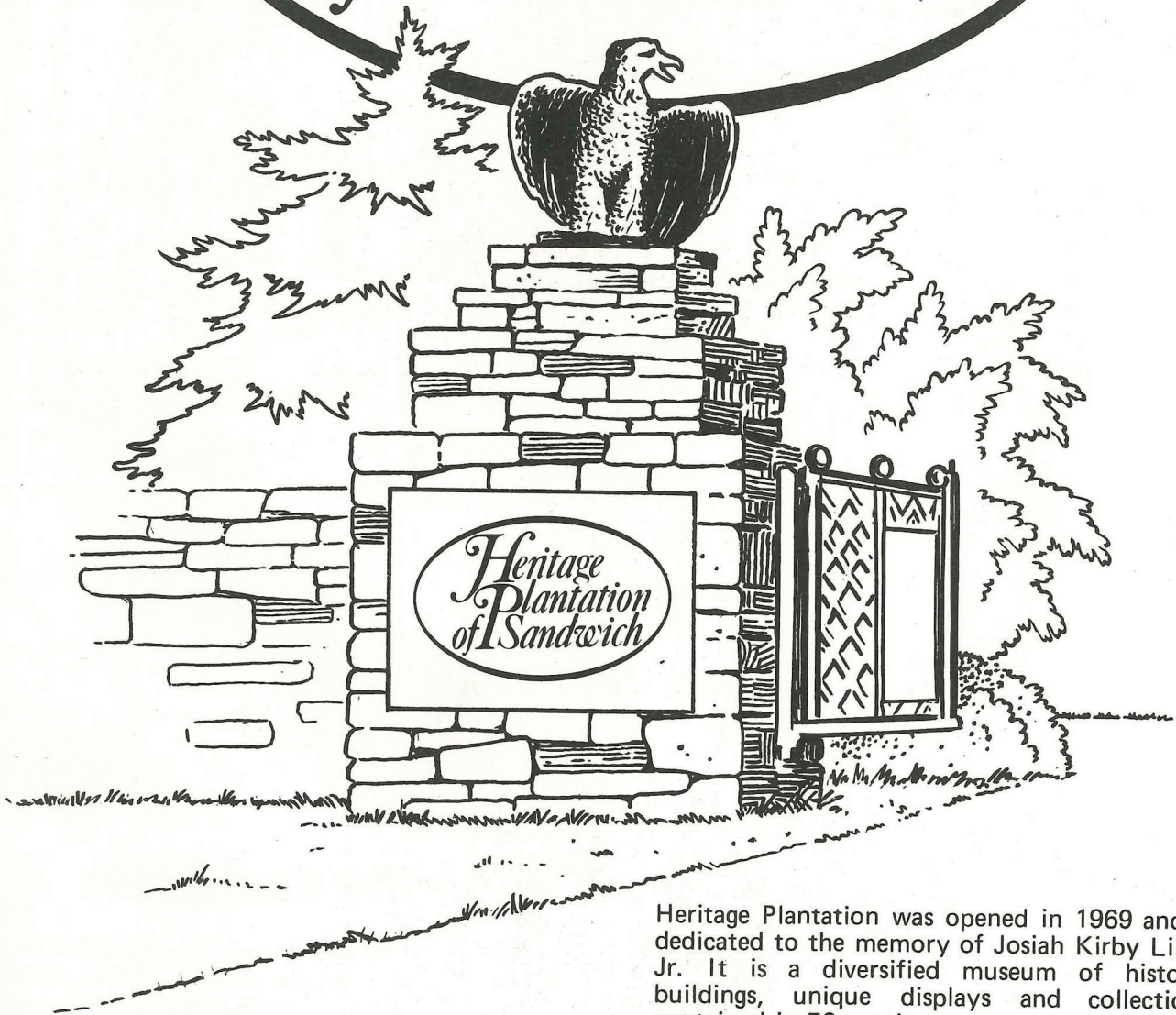


Heritage Plantation of Sandwich

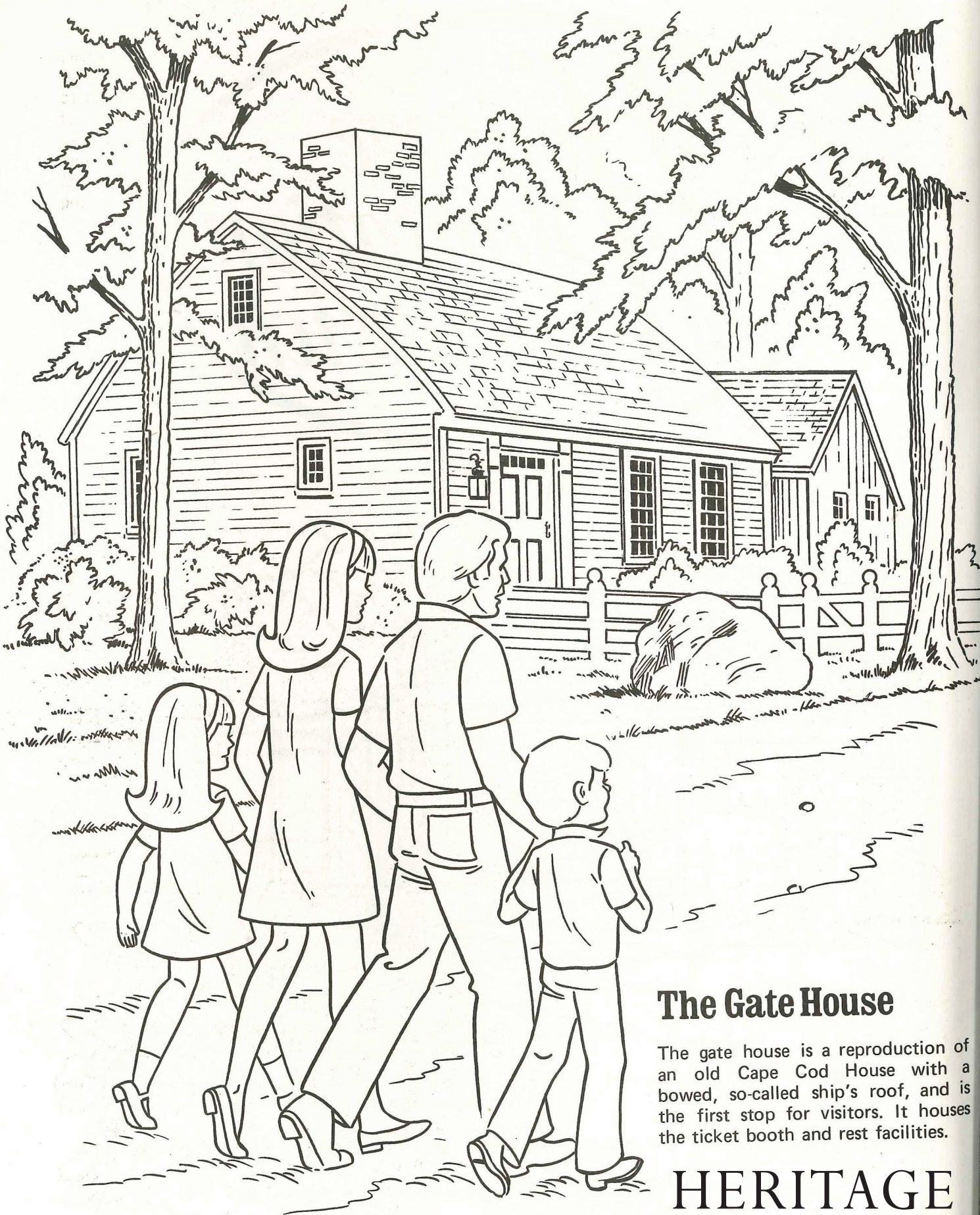

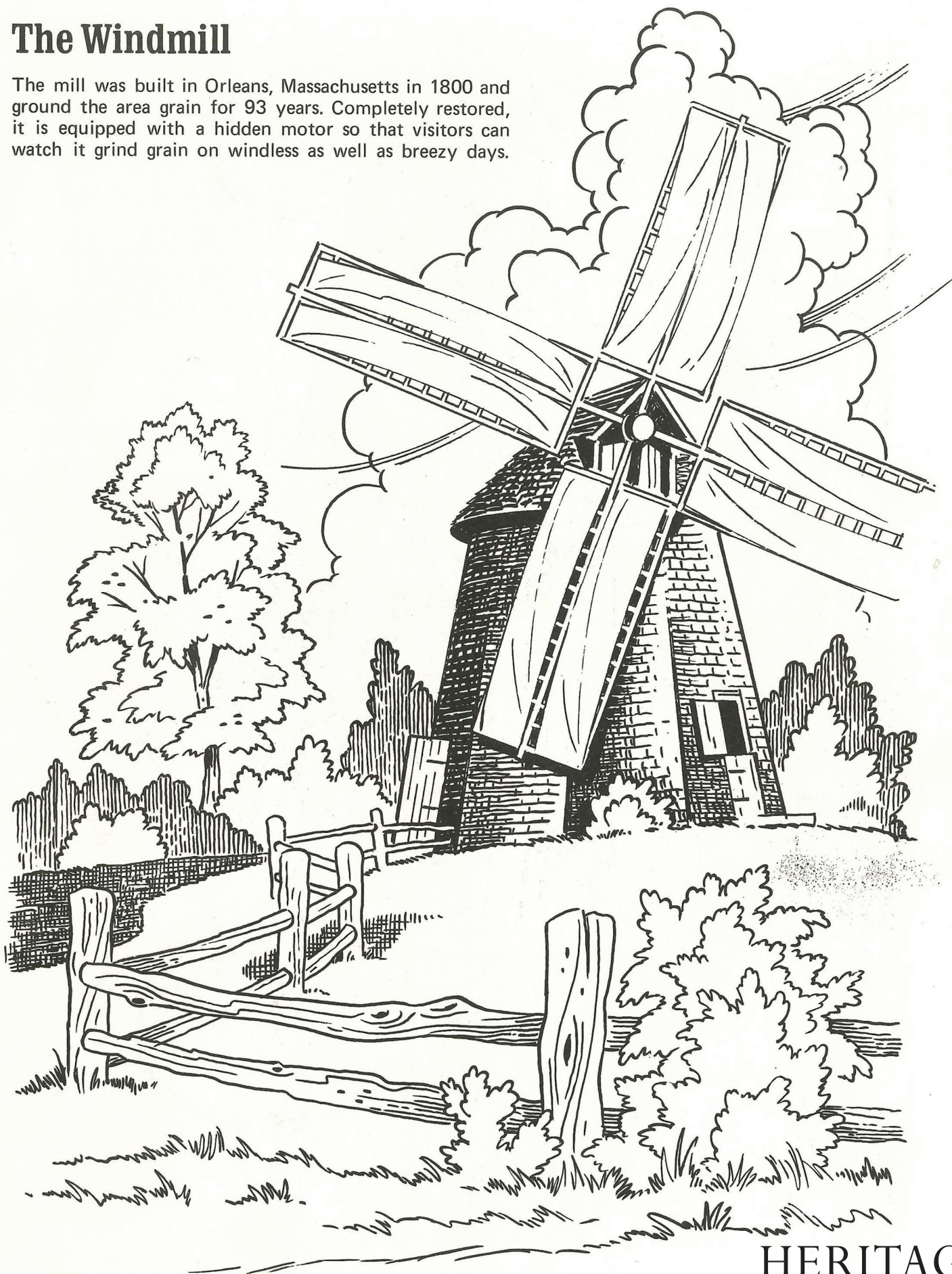
The Gate House

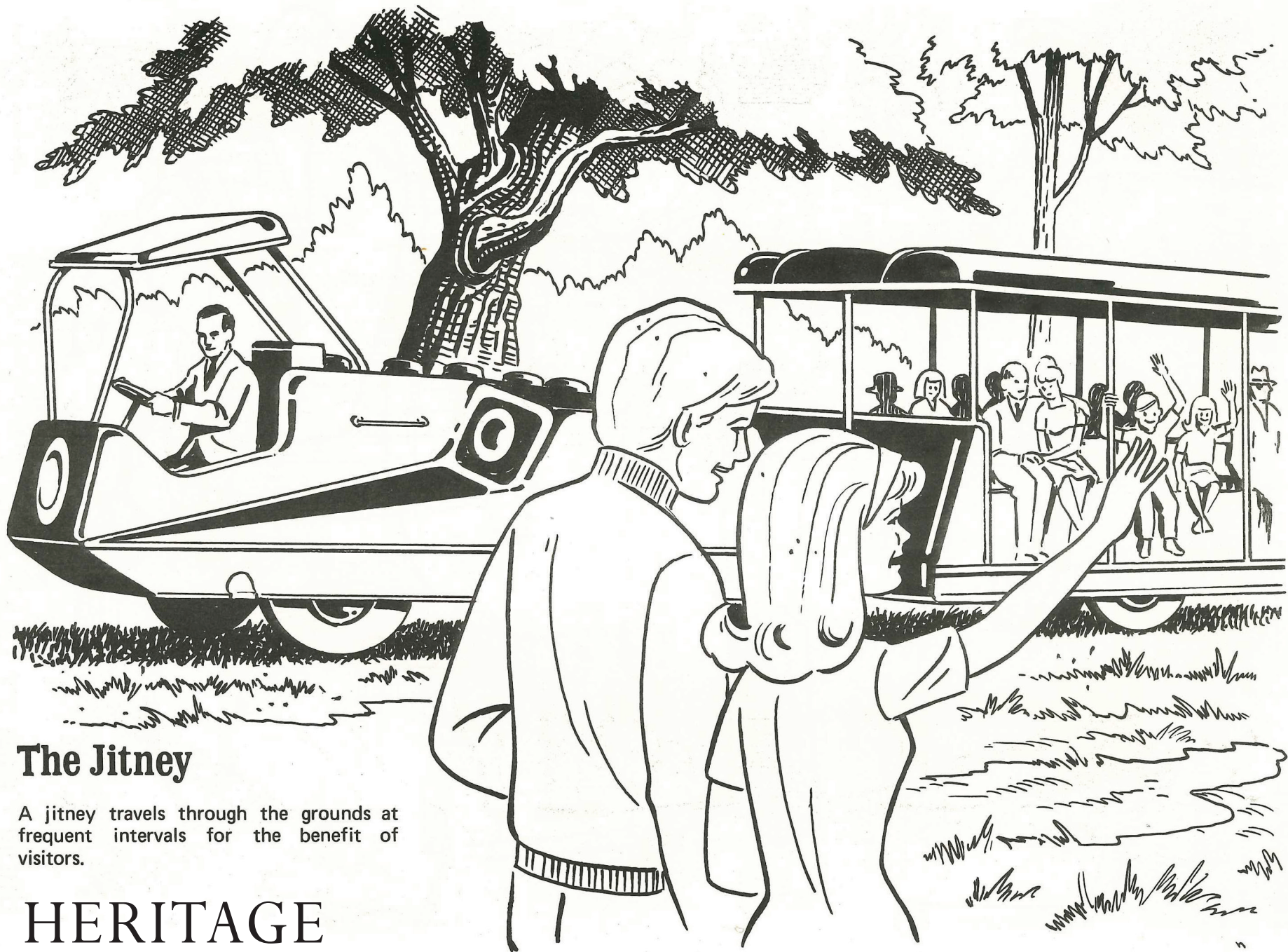

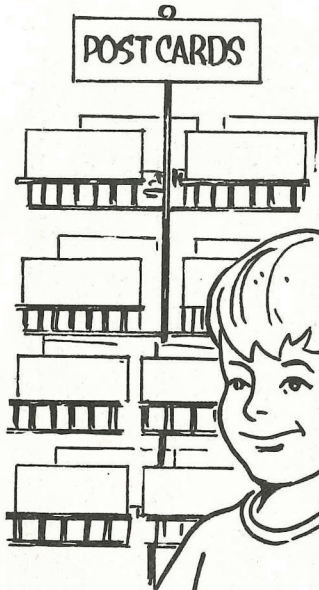


The Jitney
