Top Ten "Must See" Spots at Heritage!

- 1. The J.K. Lilly Ill Automobile Gallery: Explore Heritage's superb collection of antique cars that illustrate the evolution of the automobile. Check out examples of early electric vehicles and their chargers in a special exhibit.
- 2. The McGraw Family Garden of the Senses: Engage all your senses as you stroll this colorful, accessible, and tranquil garden area that includes a boardwalk, water features, and a 200+ year old windmill.
- 3. The Hydrangea Gardens: Stroll through the Cape Cod Hydrangea Society Display Garden and the North American Hydrangea Test garden to learn more about this iconic plant.
- 4. The Labyrinth: Relax, meditate, and commune with nature under the trees as you travel this winding pathway.
- 5. The Special Exhibitions Gallery: Immerse yourself in *Impressionist New England: Four Seasons of Color and Light*, an exhibit of both historical and contemporary paintings inspired by New England's landscapes, its people, and its glorious light.
- 6. Wetu and mush8n: Experience a full-sized reproduction of a Wampanoag dwelling and a 12' boat you can sit in to learn more about what life was like for the Indigenous people who lived here pre-colonization.
- 7. Hidden Hollow: Splash, move, play, climb, create, explore, and more in this outdoor discovery area.
- 8. Outdoor trails: Outdoor sculpture throughout the grounds: Discover bold, colorful artworks that are part of Alfred Glover in the Garden, a solo show featuring work by this local artist.
- 9. Dexter Display Garden: Explore this two-acre garden that features an impressive collection of rhododendrons hybridized by noted horticulturist Charles O. Dexter who lived on this property from 1921-1943.
- 10. The American Art & Carousel Gallery: Enjoy a ride on the 1908 Looff carousel and view a variety of folk art and everyday objects made by Cape Codders in the *Heritage Highlights* exhibit.
