- 1. The J.K. Lilly Ill Automobile Gallery: Explore Heritage's superb collection of antique cars that illustrate the evolution of the automobile. Check out the newest acquisition on display the iconic 1942 Willys MB Jeep!
- 2. The McGraw Family Garden of the Senses: Engage all your senses in this accessible and tranquil garden area that features a boardwalk, water features, and the Old East Mill, celebrating its 225th anniversary!
- **3. The Hydrangea Gardens:** Stroll through the Cape Cod Hydrangea Society Display Garden and the North American Hydrangea Test garden to learn more about this iconic plant.
- 4. The Labyrinth: Relax, meditate, and commune with nature under the trees as you travel this winding pathway.
- 5. The Special Exhibitions Gallery: Discover the *Bountiful Bogs: The Massachusetts Cranberry Story* exhibit, featuring Heritage's newly acquired cranberry collection, and explore how this humble berry has fundamentally shaped the culture, economy, and environment of Cape Cod for hundreds of years. Opening May 16.
- 6. The Wetu and Mush8n: Experience a full-sized reproduction of a Wampanoag dwelling and a 12' dugout canoe you can sit in to learn more about what life was like for the Indigenous people who lived here pre-colonization.
- 7. Hidden Hollow: Splash, move, play, climb, create, explore, and more in this outdoor discovery area.
- 8. Nature Trails: Meander along some of the several miles of nature trails, rich with wildlife and the melodies of songbirds, that wind through the grounds.
- 9. Dexter Display Garden: Explore this two-acre garden that features an impressive collection of rhododendrons hybridized by noted horticulturist Charles O. Dexter who lived on this property from 1921-1943.
- 10. The American Art & Carousel Gallery: Enjoy a ride on the 1908 Looff carousel and view a variety of art and objects celebrating the many ways in which Cape Codders have interacted with the Atlantic Seaboard in our *Heritage Highlights* exhibit.
